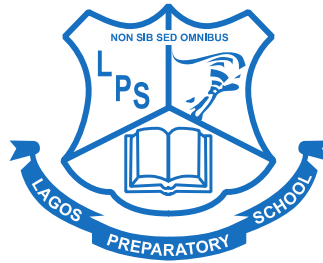

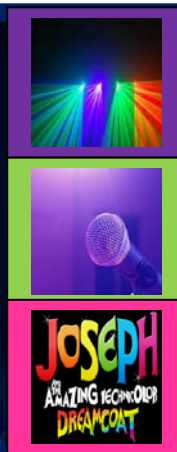
Pirate Week!

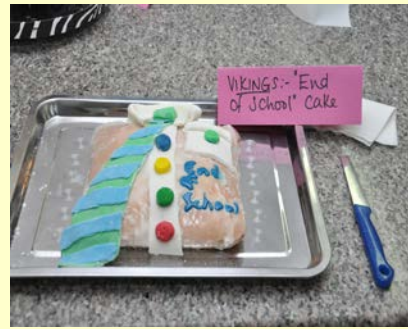
