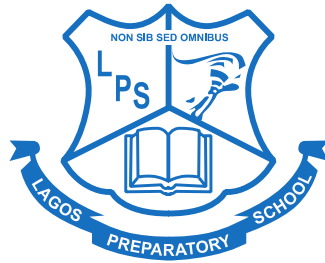

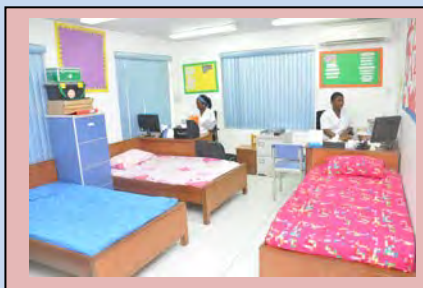
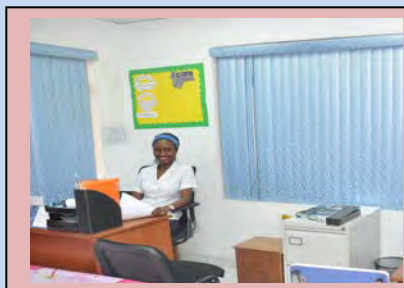


FROM THE NURSES' DESK
