Trinity Term 2016 - Curriculum Overview

In the belief that happy and confident children learn the best, Pre-nursery seeks to encourage a genuine enthusiasm for learning. All the children will spend majority of the day with their teacher, learning through play.

★ Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be encouraged to build relationships with other children through play and develop independence from their care givers. They will also learn to express themselves better and develop an awareness of others.



★ Communication and Language



The children will develop their speaking by using questions, incorporating new vocabulary into speech and by using simple sentences and word endings. They will also learn to understand complex sentences and simple concepts. They will learn to listen and respond to familiar sounds.

★ Mathematics



Children will revise number names and will learn to count objects. They will also explore quantities and associated vocabulary. They will be introduced to time based events and encouraged to anticipate these events.

★ Understanding the World

The children will explore their families and cultural backgrounds and see how they differ from others. They will also learn to operate various toys and equipment.



★ Physical Development



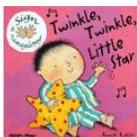
The kids will develop sturdiness on their feet as they run, squat, kick and climb and in their hands as they draw and handle tools and this will show their dominant hand. The children will also be potty trained.

★ Expressive Arts and Design

The children will explore colours, blocks, marks and music. They will develop their imagination by engaging in make believe and representational drawing.



★ Literacy



Children will continue to engage with familiar stories by repeating words and completing phrases. They will also learn to distinguish between the different marks they make.
