Trinity Term 2016

Welcome to the Trinity Term. We have lots of exciting activities lined up for this term. Please feel free, to approach any of the teachers after school hours, if you have any questions or concerns.

Literacy:

In our literacy this term, Phonics will continue to feature strongly. Phonics involves the mastering of sounds and it letter formation as well as the ability to blend the various sounds to form words. Emphasis will be made on identifying the following vowel phonemes and graphemes sounds and giving examples of words with them: ai/ay/a-e, oa/ow/o-e, ie/igh/i-e/y, /ee/, /ea/, x, y, ch, sh, th, th,qu, ou,/oi/.

We shall continue with our reading and shall be focusing on the phonics Bugs series. Children will continue to identify and give examples of rhyming words and make sentences from pictures, write dictated sentences and make words with clusters cl, cr,gl, gr, pl, pr, bl, br,fl,fr,sl,tr.

Communication and Language:

Children will always be given the opportunity to express themselves by narrating weekend and holiday events, retelling stories, reciting anthems, giving facts about insects, sequencing events from a movie and representing them in drawing.

Understanding the world:

In science the children will be learning about light sources, reflections and materials that can reflect light. They will also identify dull and shiny objects, bright and dark places and explore different shades of colors. They will be taught about different sounds and how to identify high, low, quiet and loud sounds. They will be given the opportunity to identify objects that can be pulled and/or pushed and say the effect of the action.

Mathematics:

In Mathematics this term, we shall be focusing on identifying, naming and describing properties of 2d and 3d shapes. Children will be working with number names in order up to 30, comparing numbers using more and less and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. They will compare length and height of two or more items. They will continue to add by putting together and subtract by taking away. They will be given opportunity to select two numbers that make a given total.

Expressive art design:

This term children will continue to express their artistic abilities in drawing and collaging. They will be using different media to make insects and other small creatures. The children will make flags of their own country and other countries. They will be making a craft representation of an umbrella and role playing the jobs of people who help us.

Physical Development:

This term, we shall be learning how to use tools properly to water plants and clean the garden. They will identify healthy foods and say their importance. They will explore objects in a variety of ways by throwing and catching. Children will play indoor games like puzzles, balancing beanbags and musical chair dance.

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development:

Children will learn to care for flowers, gardens and small creatures. We will discuss the dangers of and safety around insects. They will learn and talk about own countries and describe flags of other countries. They shall also be taught about what to wear during rainy season and discuss safety during rainy season. They will be given opportunity to name people who help us and describe their jobs. They will also identify clothes suitable during summer.
