### *Foods from Around the World*

Analysing and finding out about the 7 continents of the world, the countries within them and the variety of foods and dishes that come from countries. A variety of dishes will be cooked and the nutritional value analysed.

## English

Selected Class Novel.

Analysis of characters, plot and settings. Developing log entries.

Writing and re-editing different chapters.

## Art & Design

### *Objects and Meanings*

In this unit children select, arrange and present objects in a still-life painting. They investigate the work of artists who have used the theme of still life in a variety of ways to convey ideas and feeling. They develop skills of observation and recording, and knowledge and understanding of colour, tone and composition.

## Computer Studies

Using an object based graphic package to produce images and visual models. Differences between an object based program and paint package. Identifying patterns and relationships. Geographical maps and Science diagrams.

## Geography

### *Water and the Water Cycle*

Exploring how water gets to where it is needed. Who uses water? How can water be made useable? Understanding the water cycle.

## Music

Recorder playing. Learning to play studies and pieces from Novello Book I (Primary National Curriculum) Reading and writing Music, using manuscript books. Increasing song repertoire (singing and performing) in preparation for assembly and the production of Oliver.

## Science

### **1. All living things**

Pupils will learn to explain the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. Describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

### **2. Animals, including Humans**

Pupils will learn to describe the changes as humans develop from birth to old age.
