For all of us, let's remember to wash our hands regularly and cover our mouths and noses when coughing.

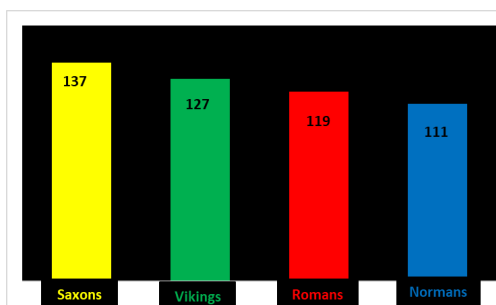
