SUBJECT	TOPICS		
English	In English, pupils will learn about: Proper nouns, commas in a list, contractions, Imperative verbs, Instructions, Adverbs, Similes, adjectives, noun phrases, auxiliary verbs, Sentence types, Exclamation mark, Compound sentences. Pupils will also explore Traditional Stories- Three Billy Goats Gruff, Little Red Riding Hood and identify their features. They will also write the beginning middle and end of traditional stories using the appropriate features of the genre. In addition, they will learn to answer comprehension questions from a wide range of texts by locating, inferring and deducing from given texts. They will engage in speaking and listening activities and contribute to discussions in the classroom.		
Maths	Pupils explore number sequence by counting, writing, ordering and comparing numbers by counting in 1s, 2s, 5s, 10s, etc, Addition of numbers with or without renaming, Subtraction of numbers with and without renaming, Number Bonds/Family, Number Names, Rounding up to the nearest ten, Multiplication Facts linked to counting in groups of 2s, 5s, 10s. Numbers halfway between, Expansion of Numbers, Introduction to Fractions, Introduction to Money (Pounds and Pence).		
Science	In Science, Pupils will explore the following units: Sources of Light Shadows, Sun as a source of light Facts about the sun. Electricity.		
History	In History, pupils will learn about Communication from the past, Telephones then and now, Telephone Models, Black History - Nigeria Independence, Black History – Proud to be(Consider an inventor)
